(Sign on from 7.45am, shooting starts at 9am sharp)

The classes are as follows

Any Scoped Rifle (If Using a Bipod, it must be Fixed to the Rifle and folding)

Service Rifle Class 223/556 or 762/308 (10 Round Mag, Any Scope, Bipods Fixed to Rifle and Folding, may be removed for non-prone details)

F Class / FTR Rifle (As F class/ FTR Rules)

Iron Sighted Service Rifle PRE 1955, (SMLE, No4, Etc.) No front or rear support, As Issued slings

Sniper Rifle PRE 1955, (i.e. No4T, Mauser, Mosin Nagant, Mauser Etc). front support allowed (sandbag, backpack etc, no bipods), slings only as issued, period authentic scopes only (doesn't have to be original, but must be in the spirit of)

You can enter a maximum of 3 classes

Entry Fee £20 (includes lunch)

PRIZES FOR FIRST SECOND AND THIRD, IN EACH CLASS

Course of fire

ALL DETAILS SHOT OVER 200, 400 & 600 Yards

ALL CLASSES (EXCEPT SERVICE RIFLE):

All distances shot from the prone position or from a shooting bench (bring your own)

Targets

Any Scoped Rifle: Standard NRA V Bull targets Irons Service and Sniper Rifle: Tin Hat Targets

F Class: Standard NRA F Class Targets (300 target at 400)

Procedure

2 sighting shots in 2 minutes at each distance, individually marked. Followed by one string of 10 shots in 3 minutes, once completed all ten shots will be marked and target shown.

CIVILLIAN SERVICE RIFLE CLASS

2 sighting shots in 2 minutes at each distance from either standing sitting or prone position, individually marked back.

followed by one string of 10 shots in 3 minutes as follows:

Nice and Steady:

200 Yards, Fig 12 target Shot from the standing position.

You Must Be Kidding:

400 Yards,: Fig 12 Target Shot from The Sitting Position

Know Your Limits:

600 Yards Shot from The Prone Position, targets as follows

1 Fig 11 Target, Hits score 50% of Normal Score,

1 Fig 12 Target, Hits Score75% of Normal Score

1 Fig 14 Target Hits Score100% of Normal Score.

The Choice Is Yours!! All targets scored 5 points for a hit in the outer ring, 4 points anywhere else on the target. (except know your limits). Scores will be radioed back to the firing point, to be marked on your score card. The scores from all three distances will be added together to determine the winning individuals.
