

## **LANE/SAFTEY OFFICER**

The Lane / Wing Officer is responsible for the supervision of one lane, group or individual under the instruction of the R.C.O.

- a) Check rifles, i.e. bolt out, breech flag in, lever actions open, before the firer occupies the firing point, and that they remain this way until the order to load is given.
- b) Accompanies the firer or group of firers, during the course of fire.
- c) Make sure the firer or group of firers, keeps his or their rifles pointed down the range and parallel to the ground at all times during the detail.
- d) Indicate to the R.C.O. when the firer or group of firers are ready (verbal).
- e) Indicate to the R.C.O when time is needed for reloading during a detail, by holding arm in the air and shouting " NOT READY".
- f) Check all firearms used on lane are clear at the end of the detail, and report to the R.C.O.
- g) Ensure no one leaves the firing point until the order has been given.
- h) Report to the R.C.O. any incident that contravenes instructions, whether written or verbal.
- i) Ensure that all empty cases are picked up and no LIVE ROUNDS are left behind.
- j) If at any time you think a dangerous situation is presenting itself shout STOP, STOP, STOP. And report it to the R.C.O.
